### Identified Strengths:

### Areas of opportunity for Growth:

- Increase external communication and partnership with parents and community stakeholders.
- Improve parent participation for on campus activities.
- Provide sources of assistance to families to meet their social/economic needs.

### Goals for Continuous Improvement:

- Increased enrollment of eligible English Language Learners.
- Use the Student Progress Monitoring tool three times a year with all students.
- Continue providing teacher/para professional development to enhance instruction in the classroom.
- Interpreters will be provided more consistently.
- Provide families with domain specific strategies to support child development at home.

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
